Laya Taal Samvaad is a Percussion ensemble which explores the various facets and intricacies of Laya and Taal in the Traditional Hindustani and Carnatic Streams of Music. Thus all the items to be presented will be in various traditional Taals in both the Streams.

The instruments that will be played are:- *Tabla and Pakhawaj* by Pandit Sadanand Naimpalli *Ghatam and Mridangam* by Mr. Shankar Lakshman *Tabla* by Mr. Jayesh Rege *Dholki* by Mr. Anil Khairnar *Dhol by Mr. Vijay Jadhav*

In the Presentations each percussionist will present Solos on their respective instruments initially in the Chatusra Jaati followed by solos in other Jaatis and Padhant (Recitation). There will also be duets and then rapid exchanges between the percussionists, tapering down to a combined playing of all the instruments, culminating in a Crescendo!

The entry to the Concerts is free. All interested are cordially invited.
